## **program** SCULPTURE

The sculpture course allows students, beginners to advance, to choose from the variety of materials to create a sculpture. From clay modeling to ceramic and from plaster to marble, depending on the level of knowledge and the type of material you can choose to focus in a specific technique or diversify the techniques.

During the course students may study the following

### **Terracotta (Clay)**

- Technology of materials
- Study of tools used for modeling
- Choice of subject and realization of preliminary drawing
- Modeling of clay, bas-relief and full-relief
- Carving technique
- Firing of works in the kiln
- Glazing of terracotta
- Glazed ceramics

### **Marble**

- Technology of the materials: various types or marble
- Study of sculpting tools
- Study of subject and realization of preliminary drawing
- Construction of the sculpture
- Polishing and Cleaning

### **Plaster**

- Metal frame construction for direct application
- Casting methods
- Final cleaning
- Painting

This course is available in the following levels of attendance:

### **INTENSIVE COURSE**

**Duration:** from 2 weeks to 12 months

**Hours:** 20 hours a week

### **SEMI-INTENSIVE COURSE**

**Duration:** from 2 weeks to 12 months

**Hours:** 10 hours a week

### **BASIC COURSE**

**Duration:** from 2 weeks to 12 months

**Hours:** 6 hours a week

Lessons are taught in Italian and/or in English language. Materials are not included in the course price. At the end of the course students will receive a certificate of attendance (diploma).
